#### 11 MUSEUM «FACHWERKERLEBEN» -**«HALF TIMBERING»**

At the house Girsberg, the oldest recorded timbered house in the rural area of Switzerland – built in 1420 – the historic technique of wood construction can be experienced. #### 8 SULZER AREAL: INDUSTRIAL HERITAGE D2/H5

The Sulzer areal, a symbol for Winterthur's transformation, is located directly by the main train station in the heart of the city. The culturally diverse district for living and leisure, which has a unique charm, emerged in 1990 on the grounds of the former industrial site. Its past can still be felt today.

#### INDUSTRIEVELOWEG WINTERTHUR

More than 200 years of industrial history have left their traces in Winterthur. The Industrial Bike Route follows them for 22 kilometers. Starting at the Main Station the trail leads to the rice mill in Hegi, then back to the city centre to the site of Sulzer and on to the former spinning plant Hard, ending again at the Main Station. Information panels document the twenty most important corner stones of the industrial development in Winterthur.
